



## Threatened trees on Prince of Wales Road

These trees provide numerous important benefits for the local residents.


- 1. They protect residents and school pupils from the noise pollution of the heavy traffic.
- 2. They absorb pollution from the cars in an area where the air quality is very poor.
- 3. They soak up rainwater, reducing the risk of flash flooding.
- 4. They give shade in hot summers.
- 5. They are an important visual amenity.
- 6. They are an important habitat for birds and wildlife.



















